3. Matters arising from the minutes:
 - a) Drainage and flooding in The Folly: - A survey has been conducted by SGC with cameras etc. They have marked the blockages but at the present time, cannot afford the cost of repair.
 - b) WestLink buses using Cold Ashton village and car park as a parking area has stopped.
 - c) The huge potholes at the bottom of Slough Lane and at the top of Hall Lane have now been filled. The long pothole at the entrance/exit to Cold Ashton village has not been filled.

 - a) Mr Ian Lyons from Quarry Wood area of Lansdown attended the meeting to outline the issues the local residents have with the speeding vehicles on the Bath Road stretch between Lansdown and opposite Battlefields. There have been many accidents on this stretch of road and damage to resident's property. After discussion it was agreed to write to Strategic Road Safety at South Gloucestershire council asking for speed visors to be installed gathering evidence of speeds of vehicles with a view to reducing the speed limit to 40mph. It would also be very useful to have an onsite meeting rather than try to view limited data from a distance.
 - b) BL has had a meeting with the Luke Hall the MP for the district, to discuss and give him all the information on the 'Cold Ashton Village Residents Traffic Control Scheme' (KF153). He took the information away and said he would discuss it with the relevant department in SGC.
