TUESDAY 3rd FEBRUARY – Start: 10:00 am **Colerne Tuesday Tramp**

Difficulty: **MODERATE** Duration: **3.5 HOURS** Distance: **5 MILES** Start point: **FOX AND HOUNDS CAR PARK, COLERNE HIGH STREET SN14 8DB, OS REF. ST 818 711 ///CABINETS.ROOMS. PROPOSALS.** A walk around the various footpaths of Colerne parish. Bring a mid-morning munchie. Park at the pub or adjacent Constitutional Club.

TUESDAY 10TH FEBRUARY – Start: 10:00 am **Sodbury Stroll**

Difficulty: **MODERATE** Duration: **3.5 HOURS** Distance: **5.5 MILES** Start point: **44 CHURCH LANE, OLD SODBURY, BRISTOL BS 37 6NB, OS REF. ST 756 817 ///FANS.VIVID.PRICE.** Starting from Old Sodbury Church, this regular monthly walk will visit the footpaths of Old Sodbury and the surrounding area. Visiting local historic locations, viewpoints, churches and varied footpaths in the area. Please bring a drink and a mid-morning snack. This our new monthly guided walk.

Difficulty: **MODERATE** Duration: **3.5 HOURS** Distance: **5 MILES** Start point: **BOX PARISH RECREATION GROUND CAR PARK SN13 8NT, OS REF. ST 824 687 ///LOOM.POTHOLE. STEADY.** This walk is also accessible by bus from Bath, Corsham, Chippenham (31/X231) and Bath, Devizes and Melksham (273). A walk around the footpaths of Box parish. Bring a drink and a snack.

FRIDAY 27TH FEBRUARY – Start: 10:00 am **A Way, a Hill and a Stile**

Difficulty: **MODERATE** Duration: **3.5 HOURS** Distance: **6 MILES** Start point: **LANSDOWN PARK AND RIDE, BATH OS REF. ST 731 680 ///VEAL.CHAINED.WIRES.** From Bath city centre public transport service 31 goes to the P and R site. We walk past Beckford's Tower before descending to the Cotswold Way which we follow through Bath before heading north up a short, steep climb. We take a detour to reach the summit of Kelston Roundhill where there are views towards Bath and Bristol. Binoculars will be useful. We return via Prospect Stile and the Racecourse to the start point.
